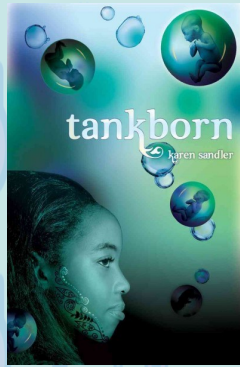


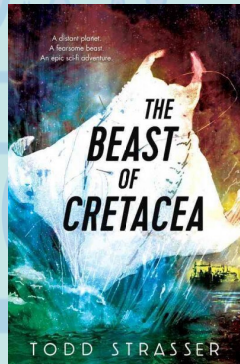

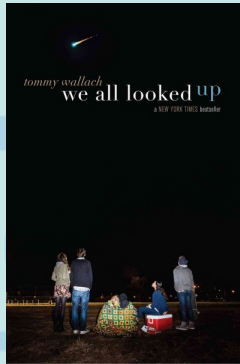
The Beast of Cretacea

The lives of four high school seniors intersect weeks before a meteor is set to pass through Earth's orbit, with a 66.6% chance of hitting and destroying all life on the planet.



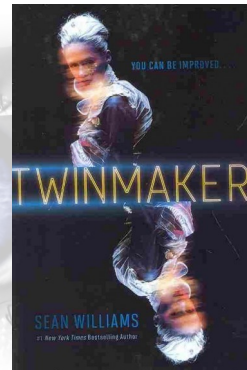

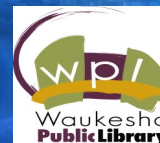
The 5th Wave

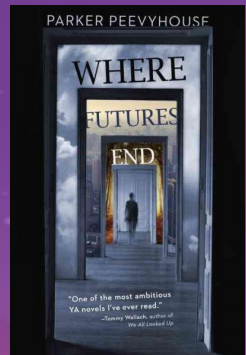
The Knife of Never Letting Go

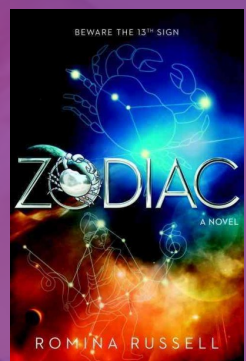
