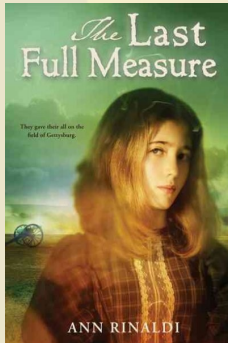
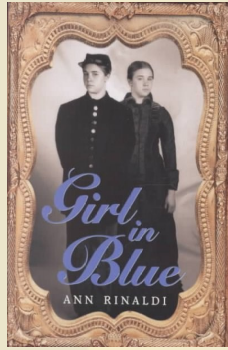


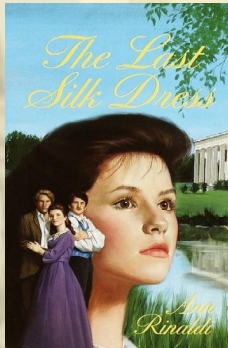
Girl in Blue

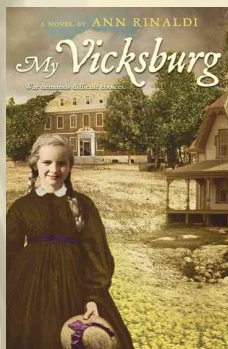
The Last Full Measure

During the Civil War, Susan finds a way to help the Confederate Army and uncovers a series of mysterious family secrets.

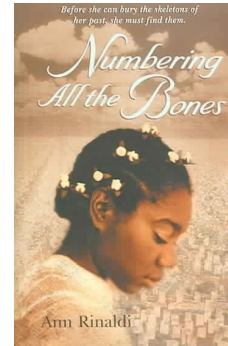

During the siege of Vicksburg, thirteen-year-old Claire Louise struggles with difficult choices when family and friends join opposing sides of the war.

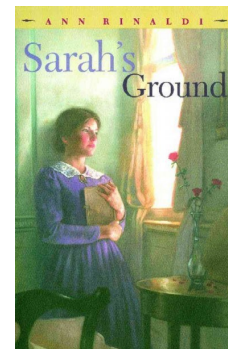
Numbering all the Bones

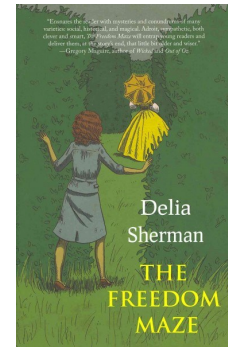

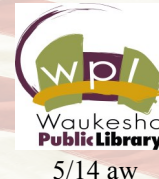
The Freedom Maze

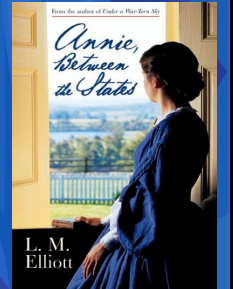

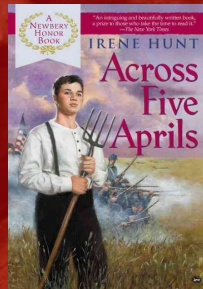

Young Jethro grows from a boy to a man when he is left to take care of the family farm in Illinois during the difficult years of the Civil War.



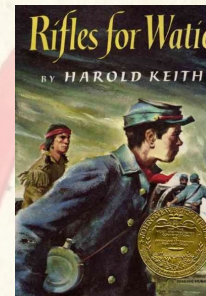
Josephine and the Soldier

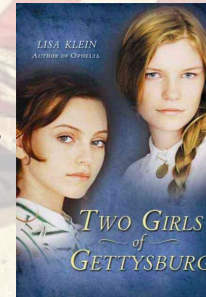

With fighting erupting around his Kansas farm, Jefferson can hardly wait to join the Union forces, only to discover that the enemy is much like himself.



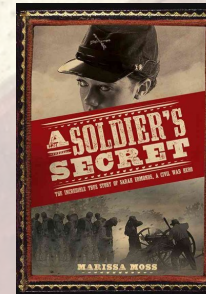
Two Girls of Gettysburg

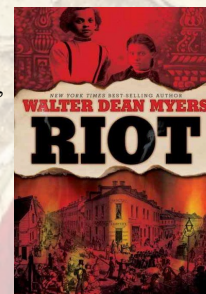

In alternating passages, a young White House seamstress named Bella and the actor John Wilkes Booth describe the events that lead to the latter's assassination of Abraham Lincoln.



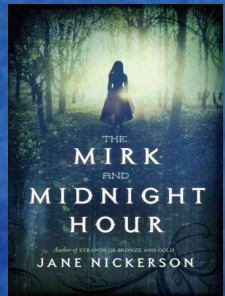

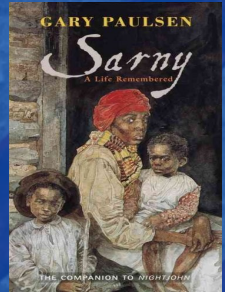
The Mirk and Midnight Hour

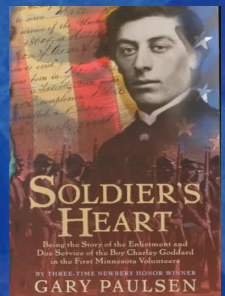

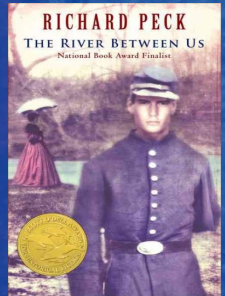
