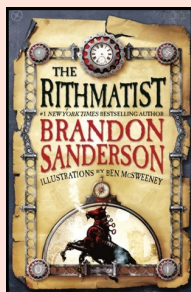

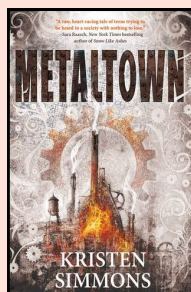


Timekeeper

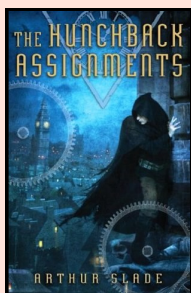


Metaltown

In Metaltown, Ty endures the hardships of working on the factory line, while Lena is being prepared to rule her family factory ruthlessly, until both young women meet Colin.

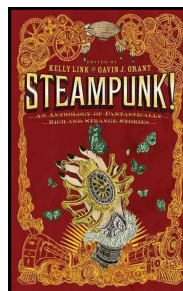


The Hunchback Assignments

Modo, a shape-changing hunchback, becomes a secret agent for the Permanent Association, which strives to protect the world from the evil machinations of the Clockwork Guild.

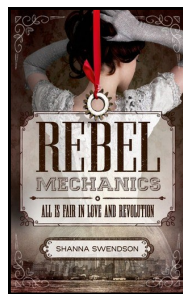


Steampunk!

A collection of fourteen fantasy stories set in the age of steam engines and featuring automatons, clockworks, and calculating machines.

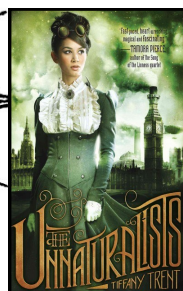


Rebel Mechanics

Verity Newton agrees to become a spy after learning that a group of rebels are developing non-magical sources of power, via steam engines, in hopes of gaining freedom from British rule.

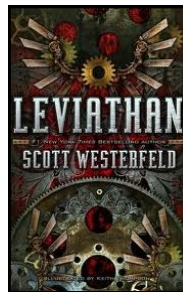
