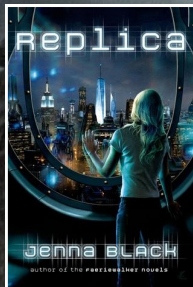
Red Queen

When her latent supernatural powers manifest in front of a noble court, Mare, a thief in a world divided between commoners and superhumans, is forced to assume the role of lost princess.



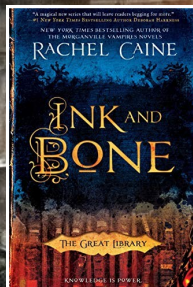
Tool of War

Nadia lives a privileged life in the Corporate States, but when her betrothed is killed and then wakes up in the replication tanks, the pair sets out to find a killer.



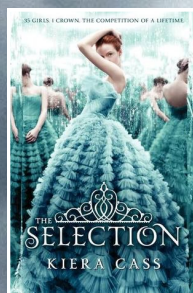
