Fridays, September 17 - October 29, 9:30 - 11:00 AM

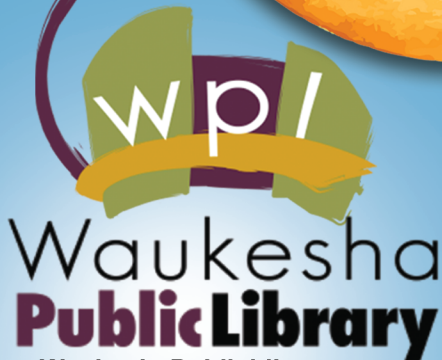
